Located within the Stanton Territorial Health Authority and reporting directly to the Manager, Ambulatory Services the Registered Nurse, (RN) Float Pool is one of 9 RNs providing culturally sensitive care to a variety of nursing units within the Patient Care Services Unit. Each of the 9 RNs, Float will need to be able to provide services in at least two of the specialized nursing units (ie. Dialysis, ICU, Labour & Delivery, Emergency or Post Anesthetic Recovery Room) and be prepared to do so 100% of the time, as well as at least two of the remaining nursing units within the hospital (ie. ECU, Pediatrics, Surgery, Surgical Day Care, Medical Day Care, Psychiatric and/or Medicine).

Qualifications for this position are commonly acquired through the successful completion of a Nursing Degree and two years recent experience in three or more different nursing unit (ie. ICU, Pediatrics, Obstetrics, Medicine, Surgery, OR, PARR, ECU, Psychiatry, Emergency, Clinics, Surgical Day Care, Medical Day Care and/or dialysis). Within the Stanton Territorial Health Authority Registered Nurses must be registered with the RNANT/NU.

The salary starts at \$39.16 per hour (approximately \$76,362 per annum), plus a northern allowance of \$3,450.

A job offer is contingent upon a satisfactory criminal record check. The successful candidate will be required to obtain a medical clearance.

This competition may be used to fill similar positions that become available over the next six months.
