The Stanton Territorial Health Authority (STHA) is offering challenging nursing work and work life balance. Join our health care team as a Registered Nurse (RN). STHA is a 100 in-patient bed accredited facility in Yellowknife, and is a referral center for approximately 37,000 regional residents of the Western Arctic and Kitikmeot Region. The STHA provides health care services to adults and children on an inpatient/outpatient and outreach basis in order to restore health with dignity.

Located within the STHA, and reporting directly to the Clinical Coordinator of Obstetrics, the Registered Nurse (RN), Obstetrics Unit, is one of 14 RNs providing care to low to high-risk patients of the 13 bed Obstetrical Unit. The Labour & Delivery Section of the unit consists of 4 additional beds. The Obstetrical unit averages 600 births per year and on any given day there is an average of 5 patients in the unit. Every Relief RN may be required to act as the Team Leader depending on staff make up and experience of the staff on duty during a particular shift. The Relief RN will work in one of the following three areas during their shift: Labour & Delivery Section; Nursery and/or In-patient rooms.

Qualification for this position is acquired through the successful completion of a Nursing Degree and one year recent experience within an Obstetrical Unit. The completion of a Certificate in Perinatal Nursing would be an asset. Within the STHA Registered Nurses must be registered with the RNANT/NU. Equivalent combinations of education and/or experience will be considered.

The salary starts at \$39.16 per hour (approximately \$76,362 per annum), plus a northern allowance of \$3,450.

A job offer is contingent upon a satisfactory criminal record check. The successful candidate will be required to obtain a medical clearance.

This competition may be used to fill similar positions that become available over the next six months.

Candidates must clearly identify their eligibility in order to receive priority consideration under the Affirmative Action Policy.
