**EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY**

The Seasonal Parks Officer is responsible for the effective and efficient enforcement of the Territorial Parks Act and Regulations within the North Slave Region. The incumbent monitors park operations and contractors in accordance with the Government of the Northwest (GNWT) legislation and regulation, policy and contractual agreements to ensure safe, enjoyable campgrounds and facilities and to protect park and campground environments and facilities. The successful incumbent will also provide a positive image for NWT parks to users and the general public to promote the use of parks and campgrounds and to encourage tourism in accordance with the mission of the Department.

Knowledge of enforcement theory and techniques to perform enforcement responsibilities which include Judicial Process, Basic Law Enforcement & Communication, Verbal Judo, and Defensive Tactics/OCS is required. The ability to interpret legislation, regulation and policy to assess and carry out appropriate enforcement activities is also required. The successful incumbent requires good physical health to perform enforcement and minor maintenance duties.

These knowledge, skills and abilities are usually acquired with completion of Grade 12, enforcement training and five (5) years of experience in enforcement in a park environment. Graduation from a recognized Renewable Resources Technology Program would be an asset. This position requires a Class 5 driver's license, and a first aid certificate plus CPR. The successful incumbent must be eligible for statutory appointment as a Peace Officer under the Territorial Parks Acts. Equivalent combinations of education and/or experience will be considered.

**The salary starts at \$32.60 per hour, plus a pro-rated Northern Allowance.**

**A job offer is contingent upon a satisfactory criminal record check.**

**Eligibility lists may be created from this competition to fill future term or indeterminate positions.**

**Candidates must clearly identify their eligibility in order to receive priority consideration under the Affirmative Action Policy.**
