This position is responsible for planning, development, implementation and evaluation and Management of the three distinct programs within Stanton Territorial Health Authority - the Occupational Health and Safety Program, the Infection Control Program and the Disaster Preparedness Program. The responsibility of the Occupational Health / Infection Control Coordinator includes minimizing risk of infectious disease for patients, staff and visitors, staff health and safety programming, and maintenance of disaster preparedness in accordance with Health Canada regulations, GNWT Acts, legislation and regulations as well as Stanton Territorial Health Authority mission, values, strategic plan, goals, policies and procedures.

The Occupational Health and Safety/Infection Control Coordinator reports directly to the senior management team member for Quality and Risk Management. The incumbent is the organization's expert on both the Occupational Health and Safety Program and the Infection Control Program for Stanton Territorial Health Authority, which includes an acute care hospital and off-site clinics with approximately 500 staff and contract staff, serving clients of the Northwest Territories, and the Kitikmeot Region of Nunavut. This involves in-depth knowledge related to two distinct areas of clinical practice
