Located in the Joe Greenland Centre in Hamlet of Aklavik and reporting directly to the Facility Manager, the Attendant provides for the emotional, physical and developmental needs of a group of elderly persons. The incumbent participates in staff meetings, training sessions and case planning activities. The Attendants will act in the capacity of Supervisor during the Facility Manager's absence. All duties will be performed on a rotating shift basis.

Typically, the level of knowledge, skills and abilities required is commonly acquired through the successful completion of Grade 10 and a Personal Care Attendant course with two years Attendant or directly related experience. Must maintain current certification in CPR and Standard First Aid. Equivalent combinations of education and/or experience will be considered.
